## **REDUCE RISK OF EXPOSURE TO CORONAVIRUS**

The U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has published its "Ten Steps All Workplaces Can Take to Reduce Risk of Exposure to Coronavirus" poster which is available in [English](#) and [Spanish](#), as well as 16 other language translations in an effort to educate and protect all of America's workers and employers during the coronavirus pandemic. The poster highlights infection prevention measures every employer should implement to promote each employees' safety and health during the pandemic. Some safety measures included are to encourage sick employees to stay home; staggered work shifts; encourage workers to avoid using other employees' phones, desks and other work equipment; and to use Environmental Protection Agency-approved cleaning chemicals from List N or chemicals that claim to protect against the coronavirus.
