KEEPING YOU INFORMED

CDC Mask Recommendation Lifted in Most Places for Vaccinated People

This week, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reported that fully vaccinated people no longer need to wear a mask or physically distance in any setting, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance. Fully vaccinated people may refrain from testing following a known exposure unless they are residents or employees of a correctional or detention facility or a homeless shelter. People are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine. If you don't meet these requirements, you are NOT fully vaccinated. Keep taking all precautions until you are fully vaccinated. *Note: If you have a condition or are taking medications that weaken your immune system, you may NOT be fully protected even if you are fully vaccinated.*
